

What shall I do to borrow an EBR?

In order to borrow an EBR (E-book reader) you will be asked to subscribe to an agreement, which assures us that you will take care of the device.

In case of loss or damage you will have to buy a new EBR or repay the original cost of the damaged EBR to the library.

Why am I supposed to pay in case of damage?

As EBRs are still quite expensive, stealing, breaking and ill-treating them causes an economical damage to the whole community of library users.

What's an EBR?

It's an electronic device containing an e-library of thousand of volumes in the space of a light portable object.

Why do we lend EBRs?

Because we believe in these new reading technologies.

How can you borrow an EBR?

You must be 18 and registered with the library

At the moment of the borrowing you will be asked you to sign an agreement and pay a deposit of €10 refundable upon return of the device.

How long can you borrow an EBR for?

On an experimental basis the borrowing lasts 15 days. It is renewable unless someone else has booked it. A daily fine of 0.50 € will be deducted from the deposit in case of delay in returning the device.

What shall I do if the EBR doesn't work properly?

You must return it immediately in order to allow the library staff to test it.

In case of delay in returning it you will be considered responsible for the damage.

The staff will always check the device in the presence of the borrower both on the borrowing and on the return of the device.

Which E-books are available on the EBR?

Each EBR contains about fifty digital books free from copyright (DMR).

A few books still subject to copyright are also available.

EBRs are in ePub format, a layout that makes reading enjoyable.
